The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) has received and reviewed the following Title V applications from Phillips 66 Company. These permit revisions are to incorporate the Rule 1118 Flare Minimization Plan in Section I of each facility's Title V permit and each is categorized as a Minor revision. Because the Rule 1118 performance target is shared between both the Wilmington Plant and the Carson Plant, the Flare Minimization Plan is common to both facilities. However, separate applications were required since the plan is being incorporated into Section I of each facility's permit. A 60-day public notice is also being performed pursuant to Rule 1118(e)(3). A preliminary determination has been made by the SCAQMD that the compliance plan meets all the applicable requirements of Rule 1118.
