Handbill Printers (ID No. 061785) has proposed to revise their Title V permit by adding a new lithographic printing press, modifying the existing regenerative thermal oxidizer (RTO) to vent the new press, changing permit conditions on an existing lithographic printing press, and removing a catalytic oxidizer and a number of printing presses. This is a commercial printing facility (SIC 2752) located at 14321 Corporate Drive, Garden Grove, CA 92643. This proposed permit revision under Application No. 487019 is considered a "minor permit revision" to their Title V permit. Attached for your review are the permit evaluation and draft permit for the proposed permit revision. With your receipt of the proposed Title V permit revision today, we will note that the EPA 45-day review period will begin on October 17th.

Pursuant to AQMD Rule 212 - Standards for Approving Permits and Issuing Public Notice, new or modified sources exceeding any of the specified daily maximums are subject to the public notification and comment provisions of 40 CFR Part 51, Section 51.161(b), and 40 CFR Part 124, Section 124.10.

Please find enclosed a public notice for Handbill Printers issued in accordance with Rule 212(g). The public notice provides for a 30-day comment period prior to making a final decision on the issuance of the permits, and is also being published in a newspaper of general circulation in the vicinity of the facility. This notice is being distributed to each address within a ¼-mile radius of the property line of the facility. This notice is also being sent to the California Air Resources Board, the Southern California Association of Governments, the County of Orange, the City of Garden Grove, and the State and Federal Land Managers.
