**Background/Process Description**

Inland Empire Utilities Agency (IEUA), Regional Plant 5 (RP-5) A/N 519296 was submitted for Title V permit renewal revision (03) on February 25, 2011. The Title V facility permit was issued on August 28, 2006 and is due to expire on August 27, 2011. Therefore the renewal application was timely and has an application shield, since it was submitted at least 180 days prior to the date of permit expiration. The facility is currently under an Order of Abatement Case No. 5209-4 to startup their combustion equipment and conduct required source tests after having being shut down after over a year. Public notice is required. For additional information and permit evaluation please refer to the attached evaluation prepared for EPA review.

Additionally, the following modifications have been made under Administrative Permit Revision:

**Rules Evaluatio**
