You are invited to a meeting with EPA to discuss the Soil Management, Air Monitoring, and Vapor Intrusion Mitigation plans for two planned residential developments on Fairchild Drive/Evandale Avenue.

EPA will also provide an update on EPA's source investigation of the trichloroethene (TCE) groundwater "hot spot" areas on Evandale Avenue and Leong Drive and additional TCE investigation and cleanup work activities planned in the residential areas.

Background: As part of the City's permit and EPA approval process, Soil Management and Air Monitoring Plans are required to address how potentially contaminated soil, groundwater, and soil vapors will be managed and air monitoring conducted to ensure the safety of construction workers and nearby residents. Draft Plans are being prepared for the 277 Fairchild Drive and 133-149 Fairchild Drive residential development projects. In addition, the City and EPA require a Vapor Intrusion Mitigation Plan for newly constructed buildings overlying TCE shallow groundwater contamination. TCE has the potential to migrate from shallow groundwater and upwards through subsurface soil into indoor air of overlying buildings by a process called ***vapor intrusion***.
