Construction Milestones

February 2013

- » **Factsheet** published announcing work
- » **Community meeting** for construction activities at the Holiday Inn

March 2013

- » **Construction begins** at the former Montrose Property

June 2013 (ongoing)

- » **Door-to-door notification** by EPA staff with help from the Del Amo Youth Corps begins in affected residential neighborhoods

July 2013

- » Pipeline under the Javelin pedestrian bridge is completed two weeks before school begins at Van Deene Avenue Elementary

January 2014

- » Construction of all planned wells complete

February 2014

- » **Factsheet** published as a mid-construction update

October 2014

- » Construction of the treatment plant expected to be completed

November 2014

- » *Estimated Project Completion*

Construction of Groundwater System Halfway Complete

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is over halfway complete with the construction that is the first step toward cleaning up groundwater for the Montrose and Del Amo Superfund Sites.

The EPA would like to thank residents and businesses for their patience and understanding as the work continues in your neighborhoods: drilling wells, constructing the treatment plant, and installing pipeline – that is, building the system that will clean up groundwater and protect clean drinking water in the area. We anticipate that construction will be complete and the treatment system fully operating by the end of 2014.

As a safety precaution, EPA conducts monitoring of soil and dust during construction. EPA has not found any evidence of unsafe contamination in soil or air during construction activities. We will continue to work to make sure the community is protected.




Figure 1: Groundwater Remedy

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
