Enclosed please find a De Minimis Significant Permit Revision for the Title page, Table of Contents, and Section H, of your Title V Facility Permit. The revised Sections reflect the approval of the permit revision requested in your Title V application No.474813. It includes installation of a digester gas treatment system and fuel cell used to generate approximately 900 Kw of electricity.

Please review the attached pages for the Title Page, Table of Contents, and Section H (Pages 1 through 14) carefully, insert the enclosed sections in your Title V Facility Permit, and discard the earlier versions. If you have any questions concerning changes to your permit, please contact Ken Matsuda at (909) 396-2656.

The operation of your facility is bound by the conditions and/or requirements stated in your Facility Permit to Operate. If you determine any administrative error in the Facility Permit, please contact Mr. Matsuda at the above number within 30 days of the receipt of your permit.

Please note that although the EPA has finished its review early, the 60 day period for the public to petition the Administrator to object to the permit begins the day after EPA's 45 day review period would otherwise ended (i.e., approximately June 11, 2008, to complete the entire process). Please note that if the permit is later found to require corrective steps (including, but not limited to, reopening the permit for cause), the expiration of both EPA's review period and the public petition period without EPA objection does not compromise the EPA's authority to take such measures.
