
Enclosed for your 45-day review is a proposed significant revision to the Title V facility permit for Chevron Products Company (Chevron) located at 324 West El Segundo Blvd, El Segundo, California. A public notice is required for this revision.

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) has received an application for a permit to construct and operate from Chevron for the equipment modification described in the table below. The SCAQMD has evaluated the application and made a preliminary determination that the equipment will operate in compliance with all of the applicable requirements of our rules and regulations. The public notice, revised portions of the permit and our evaluation report are attached for your review.

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NOTICE OF PROPOSED TITLE V SIGNIFICANT REVISION PERMIT

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) is the air pollution control agency for all of Orange County and portions of Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties. This is to inform the public of the intention of the SCAQMD to issue a revised Title V permit.

This is an existing facility applying for a significant revision for their Title V permit. The facility, which is a petroleum refinery, submitted application no. 552302 for a permit to construct to reconstruct Domed External Floating Roof Tank No. 189. A maximum volatile organic compound (VOC) emission increase of 1 lb/day will occur. The SCAQMD has evaluated the permit application and determined that the equipment will meet all applicable requirements of air quality Rules and Regulations including requirements of New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) 40 CFR 60 Subpart Kb that are triggered by the reconstruction of the tank.

As required by Title V of the federal Clean Air Act, the SCAQMD will revise the existing Title V permit of this facility to reflect modification of this existing equipment. The Title V permit includes all the emission limits and operating conditions imposed on the equipment. The facility is required to certify compliance with the Title V permit in addition to recordkeeping and mandatory reporting of any deviation of the permit conditions. A Title V permit is enforceable by the SCAQMD, by the federal government, and by citizens.

The proposed permit is available for public review at SCAQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765 and at the El Segundo Public Library, 111 West Mariposa Ave., El Segundo, CA 90245. A copy of the proposed permit can also be viewed at www3.aqmd.gov/webappl/publicnotices2/Search.aspx by entering the facility's ID number. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the SCAQMD pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the SCAQMD, based on credible information, is also available for public review at SCAQMD headquarters.

Comments must be post marked by September 28, 2013. The SCAQMD will consider all public comments and may revise the Title V permit in accordance with SCAQMD rules and regulations.

The public may request SCAQMD to conduct a public hearing on the proposed permit by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Danny Luong at the above SCAQMD address. The SCAQMD will hold a public hearing if there is evidence that the proposed permit is not correct or is not adequate to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements, and a hearing will likely provide additional information that will affect the drafting and/or issuance of the permit. A public hearing request must be postmarked by September 13, 2013. A copy of the hearing request must also be sent by first class mail to the appropriate facility contact person listed above.
