Subject: Proposed De Minimis Significant Revision to Title V Facility Permit for Chevron Products Co., El Segundo Refinery (Facility ID #800030)

Dear Gerardo:

Enclosed for your 45-day review is the proposed revision to the Title V facility permit for Chevron Products Company (Chevron) located at 324 West El Segundo Blvd, El Segundo, California. The revision proposed is a de minimis significant revision and a public notice is not required.

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) has received applications for Permits to Operate and Permits to Construct from Chevron for the equipment described in the tables below. The AQMD has evaluated the applications and made a preliminary determination that the equipment will operate in compliance with all of the applicable requirements of our rules and regulations. The revised portions of the permit and our evaluation reports are attached for your review.

437429	Internal Floating Roof Tank No. 172	Correction of the roof type; increase of the permitted commodity throughput; and reduction of the permitted commodity vapor pressure.
454293	External Floating Roof Tank No. 498	Addition of an existing mixer to the permit and correction of the roof height based on a strapping chart.
