

Enclosed are the revised Title Page, Table of Contents, and Section H of your Title V Facility Permit for BP West Coast Products, LLC's Carson Products Terminal located at 2149 East Sepulveda Blvd., Carson, CA. The revised permit reflects the following changes:

Section H: PERMITS TO CONSTRUCT:



544780	419716; R-F65483 (Section D)	Modification to Air Pollution Control System serving two-rack bulk loading facility by: 1. Removing/disabling the vapor recovery portion (refrigeration condenser) of the system. 2. Requiring additional source testing.

This revision is considered a "minor permit revision" to the Title V permit. The proposed permit was submitted to the EPA for review on May 3, 2013. Although the EPA's 45-day review period will expire on or about June 18, 2013, EPA has performed an expedited review of the proposed permit conditions and has no comments at this time. The permit is now eligible for issuance. Please note that although EPA has terminated their review early, the 60 day period for the public to petition the Administrator to object to the permit begins the day after EPA's 45-day review period would otherwise end. Also note, that if the permit is later found to require corrective steps (including, but not limited to, reopening the permit for cause), the expiration of both EPA's review period and the public petition period without EPA objection does not compromise the Agency's authority to take such measures.

Please review the attached sections carefully. Insert the enclosed sections into your Title V Facility Permit and discard the earlier version.

The operation of your facility is bound by the conditions and/or requirements stated in the facility Permit to Operate.
