NOTICE INVITING WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENTS

NOTICE is hereby given that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is reopening the Major Facility Review Permit for the following Facility:

The facility above received its initial Title V permit on September 1, 2001. The permit is being reopened in response to an EPA order dated May 24, 2004. The District is also adding three sources, removing obsolete conditions, responding to changes in the federal turbine standards and incorporating other corrections and changes.

No change in emissions is associated with this action.

The District invites written comment on the issues identified in EPA's order, as well as any proposed changes. All comments must be received by September 20, 2004. The public may also request a public hearing for this reopening of the permit.

Reopenings of Title V Permits are also subject to review and approval by US EPA. If US EPA has not objected to a proposed permit and District has not addressed a public comment in a satisfactory manner, the public may petition US EPA, Region IX, Operating Permits Section at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105, within 60 days after the end of US EPA's review, to reconsider the decision to not object to the permit.
