This is an existing facility, applying for an initial Title V permit that is engaged in lamps manufacturing. The facility operates four spray booths and other supporting equipment.

As required by Title V of the federal Clean Air Act, AQMD will be reissuing existing permits in the form of a Title V permit. The Title V permit will contain all of the emissions limits and operating conditions contained in the previous permits and may include additional monitoring requirements. The new Title V permit will require additional recordkeeping requirements, mandatory reporting of any violations of permit conditions, and annual certification by the permittee that the facility is in compliance with the new permit. The permit will be enforceable by the AQMD, the federal government, and citizens.
