Subject: Proposed Minor Revision to Title V Facility Permit for Chevron Products Co., El Segundo Refinery (Facility ID #800030)


Dear Mr. Rios:

Enclosed for your 45-day review is the proposed revision to the Title V facility permit for Chevron Products Company (Chevron) located at 324 West El Segundo Blvd, El Segundo, California. The revision proposed under A/N 542305 is a minor revision and a public notice is not required.

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) has received applications for Permits to Operate from Chevron for the equipment described in the table below. The AQMD has evaluated the applications and made a preliminary determination that the equipment will operate in compliance with all of the applicable requirements of our rules and regulations. The revised portions of the permit and our evaluation report are attached for your review.

542304	Auxiliary Boiler	Revision of existing source test conditions D28.13 and D29.5 to allow performance of the required source test at a boiler load of less than 80% of maximum permitted capacity.
