Dear Mr. Rios:

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) has received and reviewed a Title V Significant Permit Revision application to the Ultramar, Inc. Facility Permit. Ultramar is proposing to operate a Fuel Gas Treating Unit. The proposed permit change qualifies as a Significant Permit Revision and is subject to a 45-day EPA review (AQMD Rule 3003). The Fuel Gas Treating Unit is listed in the table below:

In addition, two local Permit to Operate/Permit to Construct were issued to Ultramar prior to the issuance of the initial Title V permit, pursuant to AQMD Rule 3002(a). The two local Permit to Operate/Permit to Construct issued were for construction of a new emergency IC engines driving a fire pump and change of condition for an existing storage tank. In accordance with device condition I30.1, Ultramar filed an application for a Title V permit revision for these equipment within 90 days of the issuance of the facility's initial Title permit. The emergency IC engine is subject to 40 CFR 60, Subpart IIII and 40 CFR 63, Subpart ZZZZ and the change in commodity stored in the storage tank results in an emission increase. Therefore, the revision is a significant revision and is subject to a 45-day EPA review (AQMD Rule 3003) and a 30-day public notice period (AQMD Rule 3006). Information on the applications is provided in the following table.
