The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is please to re-submit the initial Title V permit for the Edgington Oil Company Refinery. Enclosed for your 45-day review are the proposed Title V facility permit, the Statement of Basis, and the public notices in English and Spanish. The initial Title V permit application folder was already submitted to EPA in September, 2008, when this permit was initially released through a public notice for public review. AQMD will research EPA's website at a later date to determine the date of completion of EPA's 45-day review period.

AQMD intends to publish a 30-day public notice on or about December 15, 2008, and will make the proposed initial Title V permit available for public review in accordance with AQMD Rule 3006.
