NOTICE OF PROPOSED TITLE V PERMIT

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is hereby giving notice of its intent to issue the initial Title V permit pursuant to Regulation XXX – Title V Permits for the following existing facility:

Edgington Oil Company

(Facility ID 800264)

2400 E. Artesia Blvd.

Long Beach, CA 90805

The Edgington facility processes crude oil into products such as naphtha, kerosene, diesel fuel, fuel oil, gas oil, and asphalt. No gasoline for use by motor vehicles is produced at the Edgington facility. The processes and equipment used at this facility include atmospheric and vacuum distillation units, fuel treating system, asphalt blowing stills, storage tanks, loading racks, and wastewater treatment system.

Pursuant to Title V of the federal Clean Air Act, AQMD is proposing to reissue the existing permit for the facility in the form of a Title V permit meeting the requirements of AQMD's Regulation XXX and the Federal Clean Air Act. The Title V permit will contain emission limits and operating conditions from the existing permit issued to the facility by the AQMD. Furthermore, the new Title V permit will also include additional monitoring, reporting and recordkeeping requirements, including mandatory reporting of any violations of permit conditions and annual certifications by the responsible officials that the facility is operating in compliance with permit terms and conditions.

The Edgington proposed Title V permit was initially released through a public notice for public review on September 3, 2008. However, part of the permit (Section H Conditions) was inadvertently left out of that proposed permit. This re-notice is to provide the public an opportunity to review Section H of the permit which was missing from the proposed Title V permit when it was released for public review in September 2008. At this time, AQMD is soliciting comments on Section H of the proposed Title V permit and only comments pertaining to Section H of the proposed Title V permit will be accepted during this review period.
