
The proposed Significant Permit Revision for the above applications was submitted for EPA's 45-day review on May 23, 2013. A public notice was also issued on May 31, 2013 for the proposed permit revision. No comments were received from EPA or the public for these applications.

Pursuant to SCAQMD Rule 1714, another public notice was issued on April 24, 2014 due solely on the project's expected greenhouse gases (GHG) emissions. The public comment period for Rule 1714 ended on May 24, 2014. However, due to the United States Supreme Court's decision in *Utility Air Regulatory Group v. EPA*, 134 U.S. 2427 dated June 23, 2014 and EPA's subsequent interpretation of its own regulations <http://www.epa.gov/nsr/documents/20140724memo.pdf>, Rule 1714 no longer applies to this project.

The Significant Permit Revision is being issued under A/N 527890.


