Enclosed for your 45-day review is a proposed minor revision to the Title V facility permit for Chevron Products Company (Chevron) located at 324 West El Segundo Blvd, El Segundo, California. Public notice is not required for this minor revision.

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) has received applications for two Permits to Operate and a compliance plan from Chevron as described in the tables below. The SCAQMD has evaluated the applications and made a preliminary determination that the equipment will operate in compliance with all of the applicable requirements of our rules and regulations. The revised portions of the permit and our evaluation reports are attached for your review.

405265	NHT-1 Reactor Charge Heater (F-4531) SCR	Removal of conditions requiring monitoring and recording of ammonia-to-emitted NOx ratio and inclusion of appropriate maintenance, repair and calibration periods and allowances in parameter monitoring conditions.


