EQUIPMENT DESCRIPTION:

TRANSPORTABLE SOY FLOUR LIQUID ORGANIC FERTILIZER PROCESSING OPERATION CONSISTING OF A SOYBEAN MEAL HAMMERMILL SERVED BY A BAGHOUSE, ASSOCIATED CONVEYOR, MIXING TANK AND TWO PERMIT EXEMPT PROPANE-FIRED WATER HEATERS, 0.7 MMBTU/HR AND 0.5 MMBTU/HR EACH (PROPANE-FIRED, 5 MMBTU/HR OR LESS) VARIOUS SPECIFIED LOCATIONS, SJVUAPCD

PERMIT UNIT REQUIREMENTS

1. Approved locations for this equipment: S-6330, S-416, C-7837. [District Rule 2201] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
2. The equipment shall not be operated within 1,000 feet of the outer boundary of any K-12 school. [CH&SC 42301.6]
3. The unit must operate at least 15 meters away from the nearest receptor. [District Rule 2201] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
4. No air contaminant shall be released into the atmosphere which causes a public nuisance. [District Rule 4102]
5. Particulate matter emissions shall not exceed 0.1 grains/dscf in concentration. [District Rule 4201] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
6. No air contaminant shall be discharged into the atmosphere for a period or periods aggregating more than three minutes in any one hour which is as dark as, or darker than, Ringelmann 1 or 20% opacity. [District Rule 4101] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
7. Visible emissions from the exhaust of the baghouse serving the hammer mill shall not equal or exceed 5% opacity for a period or periods aggregating more than three minutes in any one hour. [District Rule 2201] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
8. The baghouse shall be equipped with a pressure differential gauge to indicate the pressure drop across the bags. The gauge shall be maintained in good working condition at all times and shall be located in an easily accessible location. [District Rule 2201] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
9. The baghouse shall operate at all times with a minimum differential pressure of 0 inches water column and a maximum differential pressure of 5 inches water column. [District Rule 2201] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
10. The baghouse cleaning frequency and duration shall be adjusted to optimize the control efficiency. [District Rule 2201] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
11. Replacement filters numbering at least 10% of the total number of filters shall be maintained on the premises. [District Rule 2201] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
12. Emissions from the baghouse serving the hammer mill shall not exceed 0.0335 lb PM10 per ton of soybean meal processed. [District Rule 2201] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
13. The maximum throughput of soybean meal shall not exceed 16.0 tons/day. [District Rule 2201] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
14. Differential operating pressure shall be monitored and recorded on each day that the baghouse operates. [District Rule 2201] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit

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15. Records of the daily differential operating pressure readings shall be retained on-site. [District Rule 2201] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
16. Daily records of soybean meal throughput shall be kept. [District Rule 2201 and 1070] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
17. Records of all maintenance of the baghouse, including all change outs of filter media, shall be maintained. [District Rule 2201] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
18. All records shall be retained for a period of at least 5 years and shall be made available for District inspection upon request. [District Rule 1070] Federally Enforceable Through Title V Permit
