

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION BY THE
SAN DIEGO COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT
TO ISSUE AN INITIAL FEDERAL TITLE V OPERATING PERMIT**

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with Regulation XIV - Title V Operating Permits of the San Diego Air Pollution Control District's Rules and Regulations, the Air Pollution Control Officer has made a preliminary decision to approve application APCD2011-APP-001657 for an initial federal Title V Operating Permit APCD2013-PTO-00036 for El Cajon Energy LLC a power generation facility located at 222 N. Johnson Avenue, El Cajon, California 92020.

The District performed an evaluation of the air pollution impacts of this proposal. The equipment is expected to operate in compliance with all applicable District Rules and Regulations and all applicable federal requirements. The proposed Title V Operating Permit incorporates conditions necessary to ensure compliance with all federal and District requirements. The facility is currently operating in compliance with District requirements.

The District is seeking comments on the initial Title V Operating Permit for this facility. Written comments concerning the District's proposed action may be submitted for a period of 30 days commencing on April 4, 2013 and ending on May 4, 2013. Members of the public may petition for a public hearing to receive comments on the proposed Title V Operating Permit. If the Air Pollution Control Officer determines that good cause exists, a public hearing will be scheduled.
