Proposed Minor Revision to Title V Permit for Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD), Perris Valley Regional Water Reclamation Facility (PVRWRF) (ID# 007417)

Enclosed for your review is the proposed revision to the Title V Permit for EMWD, Perris Valley Regional Water Reclamation Facility located at 1301 Case Road, Perris, CA in Riverside County. This revision is considered to be a minor permit revision and public notification is not required. We are enclosing the appropriate pages of the proposed Section D, which includes the permits as shown below, and the engineering evaluation. EMWD has requested expedited permit processing and review regarding application 510552, 510553, and 510554 to allow the replacement of the catalytic converter for the engine. The timely replacement will ensure compliance with emission limits. We respectfully request your expedited review of this proposal on or before April 25, 2011.
