This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District has made an administrative amendment to the Major Facility Review Permit for the following facility.

The facility has requested a change in the due dates for their monitoring reports because they would like the reporting period to end at the end of the month. Part 70 requires submission of monitoring reports at least every six months. This length of this period cannot be increased, but it can be decreased. Therefore, changes have been made to Standard Condition I.F so that the next monitoring period will last five and a half months and will end on January 31, 2002. All subsequent periods will last six months.
