Pursuant to Title V of the federal Clean Air Act and AQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance unless such permit has been renewed. Comments must be received by May 22, 2010. The AQMD will consider all public comments and may revise the Title V permit in accordance with AQMD rules and regulations.

The public may request the AQMD to conduct a public hearing on any of the proposed permits by

submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Hamed Mandilawi at the above AQMD address. The AQMD will hold a public hearing if there is evidence that the proposed permits are not correct or are not adequate to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements, and a hearing will likely provide additional information that will affect the drafting and/or issuance of the permits. A copy of the hearing request must also be sent by first class mail to the appropriate facility contact person listed above.
