Enclosed are the revised Title Page, Table of Contents, Section D, Section J, and Section K of your Title V facility permit. After issuance of the initial Title V permit for this facility, Tesoro staff notified the AQMD of errors in the permit. These items were determined to be oversights and typographical errors by the AQMD, therefore we are reissuing these sections of your Title V permit to include corrections as an administrative revision. In addition to punctuation and grammatical corrections the following changes were made:

Section D – Facility Description and Equipment Specific Conditions

Permit No. G1018	9	Removed entire item requiring this facility to comply with 40 CFR Part 60 Subpart XX –Standards of Performance for Bulk Gasoline Terminals.	Does not apply; facility does not load gasoline into tank trucks.
Permit No. G1018	9	Removed item requiring this facility to comply with District Rule 462 for Organic Liquid Loading.	Does not apply; facility does not load tank trucks.
