Dear Mr. Rios:

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) has received and reviewed a Title V application for a De Minimis Significant revision from Ultramar Inc., Wilmington. Ultramar is proposing to construct a new FCCU fresh catalyst and catalyst additive loader (A/N 492721) and to include a Consent Decree NOx limit on their FCCU (A/N 494177). In addition, Ultramar is opting not to install a FCCU oxygen injection system, which was permitted in 2003. Therefore, the device description and the respective conditions for the FCCU oxygen injection system have been removed.

The AQMD is required under Rule 3003(j) to provide a copy of the proposed permit to the EPA administrator for a 45-day review. As such, a copy of the proposed revision to the existing Title V permit is attached along with our evaluation for your review. Please note that the evaluation contains information designated as confidential business information by Ultramar, Inc.
