Dear Jack,

During yesterday's SAB teleconference I volunteered to put together a list of U.S. in situ facilities. Please find that list attached. I have put it together based on my experience in the industry, various company websites, the NRC website, and assistance from Oscar Paulson with Kennecott Uranium. I have attempted to indicate the status of each project. All of the pilot projects have ended or moved on to active production. I believe the list is reasonably accurate and complete; especially with regard to the current producers and those being licensed.

This list represents only U.S. in situ operations. There are many other operations around the world; especially in Australia and Kazakhstan. However, the groundwater and lixiviant chemistry in these countries tends to be very different than in the U.S. Please pass this list on to interested parties.
