Tidal Discharge Study Scope of Work***

Messrs. Harding & Brander:

In accordance with the above referenced Administrative Order and in response to the Ammonia Nitrogen Removal Engineering Report, Copper Optimization Engineering Report and EPA review letter dated May 02, 2014, please find enclosed a copy of the Tidal Discharge Study Scope of Work (SOW) for your review and approval.

The May 2, 2014, EPA review letter requests the Town of Salisbury submit to EPA and the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection a detailed SOW for a tidal discharge study. The enclosed SOW includes details of how available dilution will be estimated for a range of hydrologic conditions and treatment plant flows while establishing a study method to evaluate the available storage and the maximum flows that can be held for tidal discharge. The SOW also includes evaluating modifications to the treatment plant including the need for cost estimates and implementation schedules. In addition, the SOW addresses methods for evaluating alternate options for meeting the NPDES permit limits.
