AFFIDAVIT

I, Eugenia Quintana, being first duly sworn, depose and state that the statements in this document are true and correct, except as to matters stated on information and belief and, as to such matters, the undersigned certifies that she believes the same to be true:

1. I am employed by the Navajo Nation Environmental Protection Agency (“NNEPA”) as Environmental Department Manager for the Air & Toxics Department. As part of my responsibilities, I supervise the Navajo Operating Permit Program located at Route 112 North, Building No. F004-51, Fort Defiance, Arizona. I have held this position since June 12, 2006.

2. On October 29, 2008, Peabody Western Coal Company (“Peabody”) submitted a Clean Air Act Part 71 renewal permit application to NNEPA for the Peabody – Black Mesa Complex (the “Complex”) (Permit No. NN-OP 08-010), a CAA Title V source located in Kayenta, Navajo County, Arizona. NNEPA, pursuant to a delegation from U.S. EPA, issued the Part 71 Renewal Permit for the Complex, first on December 7, 2009 and then, after revisions were made, on April 14, 2011. NNEPA subsequently issued an administrative amendment to the permit on August 31, 2012. By virtue of my supervisory role over the Navajo Operating Permit Program, I am familiar with the materials contained within the administrative record for the administrative permit amendment.

3. I have reviewed the Certified Index of the Administrative Record and, to the best of my knowledge and belief, I find that it is complete and contains the information relied upon by NNEPA in issuing the administrative permit amendment.
