

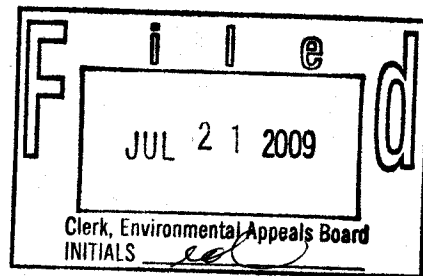

**THIRD ORDER STAYING PROCEEDINGS**

By Order dated June 3, 2009, this Board suspended the Region's obligation to file a response to ExxonMobil's petition for review in the above-captioned matter. Further, the Board ordered the parties to participate in a status conference on July 21, 2009. *See* Order Suspending Date for Filing of Region's Response and Scheduling Status Conference (June 3, 2009). During the status conference, the parties represented their strong expectation that pending settlement negotiations would be completed by September 2, 2009.

Upon consideration, and in light of these representations, the Board hereby extends the stay in this matter until September 2, 2009. By this date, the parties shall file a status report informing the Board of the progress of settlement discussions.<sup>1</sup>


