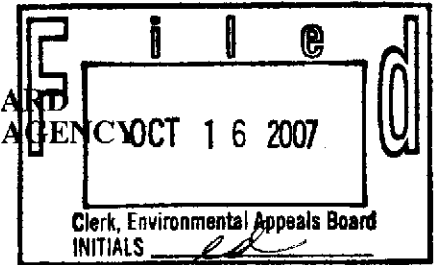

**ORDER ALLOCATING TIME DURING ORAL ARGUMENT AND IDENTIFYING
ISSUES TO BE HEARD**

By Order dated July 26, 2007, the Board directed United States Environmental Protection Agency Region 3 (the "Region"), the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority ("WASA"), the Chesapeake Bay Foundation ("CBF"), and Friends of the Earth and the Sierra Club (together, "FOE/SC") (collectively, the "Parties"), to appear for and participate in an oral argument to present their views with respect to the petitions filed in the above-captioned appeals. In that Order, the Board stated that it anticipated issuing a subsequent order allocating time among the Parties and identifying the issues to be heard at oral argument. To that end, the Board has allocated ninety (90) minutes total for this oral argument, divided as follows: (1) thirty minutes for WASA, (2) fifteen minutes for CBF, (3) fifteen minutes for FOE/SC, and (4) thirty minutes for the Region. At the outset of the proceedings, WASA, CBF, and FOE/SC may reserve five minutes of their allocated time for rebuttal. Although the Parties will be permitted to present issues related to any of the above-captioned appeals, the Board requests that the Parties focus their arguments on the issues related to

compliance schedules (raised in Appeals 05-02, 07-10, and 07-11) and the issues raised in Appeal 07-12.
