

ORDER EXTENDING STAY OF PROCEEDINGS

On September 11, 2015, the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") issued a stay in the instant matter to allow the parties to engage in settlement negotiations. On November 4, 2015, the parties filed a joint motion reporting that they have made substantial progress toward resolution of this matter, but they need more time to finalize the agreement, complete internal reviews, and prepare documentation to dismiss the appeal and effectuate the permit at issue if a final settlement is reached. Thus, the parties request an additional thirty (30) day stay to finish their discussions and complete these tasks.

For good cause shown, the Board grants the parties' request to stay this matter for an additional thirty (30) days. This matter is now stayed until **December 10, 2015**.


