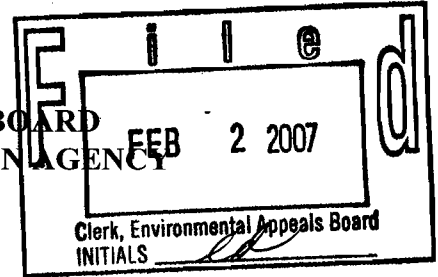

**ORDER GRANTING**

**RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

On February 1, 2007, Respondent, Euclid of Virginia, Inc., filed a motion requesting an additional 7-day extension of time to file its appeal brief. On December 1, 2006, the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") issued an order granting Respondent's first request for additional time and instructing Respondent to file its appeal brief no later than February 7, 2007.<sup>1</sup> In support of its current request, Respondent explains that the additional time is necessary because the case involves extensive research and analysis of many thousands of pages of record, the issues are in many instances novel, and the extension would not result in prejudice to any of the parties. In addition, Respondent represents that Complainant, Region 3 of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, neither objects nor consents to the request.

Upon consideration of the foregoing and for good cause shown, the Board grants Respondent's request. Respondent's appeal brief must now be filed no later than February 14,

2007, and the Region's cross-appeal, if any, must be filed within 20 days of service of Respondent's brief.<sup>2</sup>
