

### ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION

#### TO STAY THE PETITION

On December 12, 2008, the parties in the above-captioned matters, U.S. EPA Region 1 (the "Region"), Thomas Arnold (NPDES Appeal No. 08-26) and the U.S. Department of Interior (NPDES Appeal No. 08-27), filed a joint motion requesting to stay the proceedings in this case until May 8, 2009. The parties represent that they believe resolution of these appeals may be possible through settlement discussions.

Upon consideration, the Board hereby grants the parties' request, in part. The appeals are now stayed until April 8, 2009.
