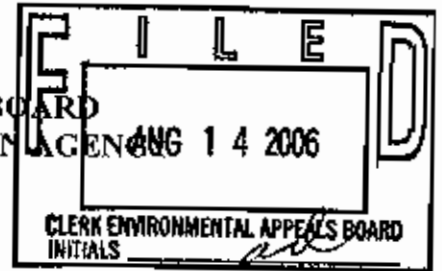

**ORDER GRANTING SIXTH MOTION
FOR STAY OF PROCEEDINGS**

On August 11, 2006, Region I of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency filed a status report and motion to extend the stay of the proceedings in the above-captioned matter, which currently runs through August 18, 2006. In its motion, Region I reports that the parties have successfully concluded settlement discussions and resolved all issues raised in the pending petition for review. The Region notes that on August 2, 2006, a consent decree was lodged in federal court for public notice and comment, and the Region seeks an additional ninety-day stay of proceedings in this case to allow sufficient time for the consent decree process to conclude. The petitioners have assented to the Region's request for an extension of the stay of proceedings.

For good cause shown, the Region's motion is hereby **GRANTED**. The parties are directed to provide the Board with a status report on or before **Friday, November 17, 2006**.
