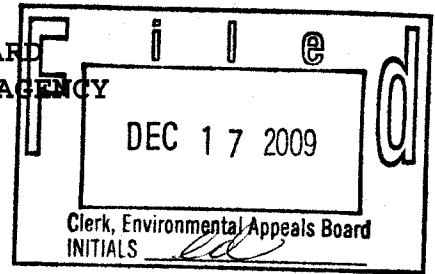

ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDINGS

On December 17, 2009, the permitting authority in the above captioned matter -- U.S. EPA Region 1 (the "Region") -- filed a motion requesting a 60-day stay of proceedings in this case. The Region represents that Petitioner and counsel for the Permittee have assented to this request. In support of its request, the Region explains that it plans to engage in negotiations with the Petitioner in an effort to narrow or resolve some or all the issues raised on appeal.

Upon consideration, the Board hereby grants the Region's request. The appeal is now stayed until February 22, 2010. By no later than that date, the Region shall file a report regarding the status of this appeals,¹ which shall include a detailed summary of

the issues resolved, remaining issues, and projected time frame for full resolution or litigation.




