THIRD ORDER STAYING PROCEEDINGS

On June 9, 2017, the Environmental Appeals Board (“Board”) stayed proceedings in the above-captioned matter until August 8, 2017, to allow the parties to participate in the Board’s Alternative Dispute Resolution (“ADR”) program. On August 7, 2017, the Board issued an order extending the stay of proceedings until September 12, 2017, to allow time for the parties to complete negotiations. On September 12, 2017, the Board issued an order further extending the stay of proceedings until October 12, 2017. The parties have reached an agreement in principle and the Settlement Judge recommends that the stay be extended seven days. For those reasons, the Board extends the current stay of proceedings an additional seven days, to and including **October 19, 2017**, to finalize the settlement.
