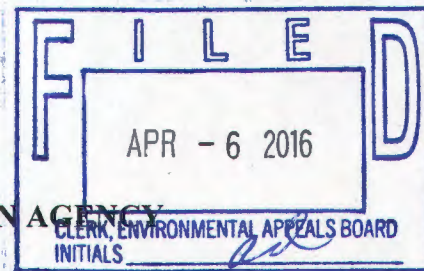

**ORDER DIRECTING THE PARTIES
TO FILE A FURTHER JOINT STATUS REPORT BY APRIL 27, 2016**

On March 1, 2016, Region 1 (“Region”) of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency filed on behalf of the parties a joint motion for an additional stay of proceedings to allow the parties to continue settlement negotiations, and to extend the Region’s deadline for responding to Invensys Systems, Inc.’s (“Invensys”) petition for review. On March 3, the Environmental Appeals Board (“Board”) granted the parties’ joint motion and stayed proceedings through May 4, 2016. On March 31, the Region filed a joint status report on behalf of the parties, advising the Board that the parties have reached an agreement in principle to resolve this appeal. The parties further report they are hopeful that an additional extension of the stay will not be necessary.

The Board appreciates the progress the parties have made in their efforts to settle this appeal, and orders the Region, in consultation with Invensys, to file a status report by Wednesday, **April 27, 2016**, to update the Board on the progress of the parties’ efforts to resolve this appeal. If the parties plan to request a further stay of proceedings, they shall provide in their

next status report information as to the progress they have made since the March 2016 status report, and their plan and timeline for resolving any outstanding issues.


