

ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSE

By motion dated November 28, 2007, U.S. EPA Region 6 (the "Region") seeks a 45-day extension of time to file its response to the petition for review in the above-captioned matter. *See* Respondent's Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to Submit a Response to Petitioner's Contentions (Nov. 28, 2007) ("Motion"). In support of this Motion, the Region states that the additional time is needed "to enable Respondent to fully respond to the Petitioner's fifty-nine (59) page petition and several hundred pages of exhibits of a highly technical nature. It will also provide Respondent sufficient time to coordinate with the Office of General Counsel and the Office of Water in the development of its response." Motion at 1. The Motion states that the San Jacinto River Authority, the petitioner in this matter, does not oppose the extension request. *Id.* at 1-2.

For good cause shown, the Motion is granted. The Region's response to the petition for review, and to Petitioner's motion to supplement the administrative record, must now be filed with the Board no later than January 30, 2008.1
