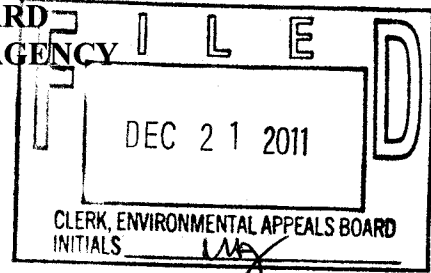

TO ALLOW PARTIES TO PARTICIPATE IN PILOT ADR PROGRAM




