The parties are directed to provide the Board with a report, on or before **Tuesday**, **February 20**, **2007**, apprising the Board of the status of the permit proceedings and suggesting a future course of action. If the permit modification is finalized prior to February 20th and the parties choose to file a motion to withdraw the petition for review on or before that date, such motion will be accepted and ruled upon in lieu of the status report.
