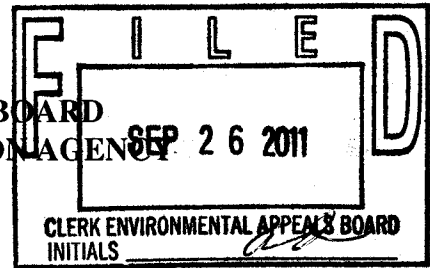

**ORDER EXTENDING BRIEFING DEADLINES**

By Joint Motion filed with the Board on September 23, 2011, *see* Joint Motion to Extend Briefing Deadlines (“Joint Motion”), the parties in the above-captioned matter, U.S. EPA Region 5 (“Region”) and ArcelorMittal Cleveland, Inc. (“Arcelor”), seek an additional twenty-one (21) days to file briefs required by the Board’s order of September 8, 2011. *See* Order for Additional Briefing (“Order”). The Order required that the Region file a substantive response to Arcelor’s informal appeal no later than September 30, 2011. In addition, the Order set a deadline of October 14, 2011, for Arcelor to file a reply. Order at 2. In support of a twenty-one day extension of these deadlines, the Joint Motions states that the additional time is needed to allow sufficient time for the Region to fulfill its obligation to consult with the Office of General Counsel and the Office of Water.<sup>1</sup>

For good cause shown, the Joint Motion is granted. The Region’s substantive response must now be filed with the Board no later than October 21, 2011. The Region’s response must

include relevant portions of the administrative record as well as a certified index to the complete administrative record. ArcelorMittal will then have until November 4, 2011 to file a reply.<sup>2</sup>


