ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR STAY OF PROCEEDINGS

By joint motion filed on December 14, 2006, U.S. EPA Region I ("Region") and Petitioner Wyman Gordon Company ("WGC") seek a 90-day stay of proceedings in the above-captioned matter in order to allow the parties to resolve this matter through settlement negotiations. The Region's response to WGC's Petition for Review is currently due on December 19, 2006.

In support of their motion, the parties represent that they are developing a schedule of settlement negotiations and that a stay of proceedings is necessary "[i]n order to allow sufficient time for settlement negotiations to conclude."

For good cause shown, the parties' joint motion is granted. The proceedings are stayed until March 19, 2007, and the Region's December 9, 2006 filing deadline is rescinded. The parties are directed to submit a status report by February 5, 2007, to advise the Board whether it

is appropriate to continue the stay, dismiss the Petition for Review, or schedule the Region's response to the Petition.
