

## **SECOND STAY ORDER**

By motion received on February 28, 2007, U.S. EPA Region 1 (the "Region") seeks an additional stay of the proceedings in the above-captioned matter until May 3, 2007. See Status Report on Settlement Discussions and Motion to Extend Stay of Proceedings ("Motion"). The Motion states that the City of Leominster ("City"), the petitioner in this matter, has consented to this request. Motion at 1. In support of the Motion, the Region states that "[t]he parties have agreed to resolve the appeal through an administrative order and compliance schedule and are currently discussing the terms of the schedule." Id. at 2.

For good cause shown, the Motion is granted. The Region's response to the City's petition for review must now be filed with the Board no later than May 3, 2007.<sup>1</sup>
