ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR THIRD STAY OF PROCEEDINGS

On May 27, 2008, Region 1 of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency filed a status report and motion to extend the stay of proceedings in the above-captioned matter. The Region seeks an extension of the current stay – until October 15, 2008 – to give it sufficient time to review and draft responses to comments received on the draft permit modification for the Mirant Kendall Station, consult with interested state and federal agencies as necessary, and finalize the permit modification. The Region reports that it discussed this status report and motion for an extension with petitioners Mirant Kendall, LLC, Conservation Law Foundation, and Charles River Watershed Association and determined that none of these parties oppose the requested extension of the stay of proceedings.

In the interest of judicial economy and for good cause shown, the Environmental Appeals Board hereby grants the motion and extends the stay of proceedings. The Region shall file a status report no later than **Wednesday**, **October 15**, **2008**. This status report shall advise whether the Board should extend the stay for another period of time, establish a revised briefing schedule, or take other appropriate action. The petitioners shall file their responses to the Region's status report no later than seven days after the filing of that report. So ordered.
