ORDER REQUESTING ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

On November 4, 2010, the City of Twin Falls ("City") filed a motion requesting a six-month stay of the proceedings in the above-captioned matter. In support of its request, the City explained that the City and EPA Region 10 (the "Region") reached "an informal agreement resolving all the issues presented in the City's two Petitions for Review, contingent upon the approval and issuance of a new section to the TMDL which, if approved and issued, will permit the City to remove [Total Suspended Solids] from non-point sources." Motion for Stay (filed Nov. 4, 2010). The City further explained that it has agreed to dismiss both Petitions upon completion of this process, which it expects to take approximately 6 months.

Before the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") rules on this motion, the Board would like the parties to provide additional information delineating the process for the TMDL modification the City describes, and a schedule of the milestones expected to be accomplished throughout the requested six-month period. This information will assist the Board in determining whether the requested amount of time is reasonable, and in establishing a schedule for status reports. Accordingly, the parties have until Friday, November 19, 2010, to file the additional information.¹ The parties may provide the information either jointly or separately.
