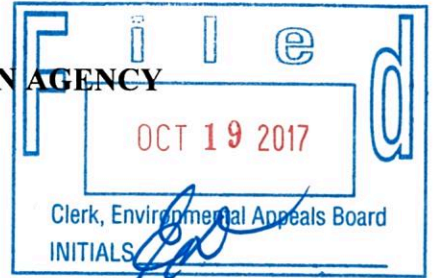

FOURTH ORDER STAYING PROCEEDINGS

On June 9, 2017, the Environmental Appeals Board (“Board”) stayed proceedings in the above-captioned matter to allow the parties to participate in the Board’s Alternative Dispute Resolution program. On October 12, 2017, the Board issued an order noting that that the parties had reached an agreement in principle and staying proceedings until October 19, 2017. The parties have made progress in finalizing the settlement, but need additional time to complete the settlement, and the Settlement Judge recommends that the stay be extended eleven days. For those reasons, the Board extends the current stay of proceedings an additional eleven days, to and including **October 30, 2017**.


