

## **ORDER GRANTING CONTINUANCE OF STAY A** FOURTH EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSE

On September 27, 2011, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") Region 6 ("Region") requested a continuance of the stay in the above-captioned matter. Previously, the Environmental Appeals Board granted a stay until September 29, 2011, for the parties to reduce to writing their agreement in principle to resolve this matter. In the Region's motion requesting a continuance of the stay, the Region requests more time to obtain the necessary signatures to a negotiated a Consent Agreement and Final Order ("CAFO"). The Region indicates that the Respondant signed the draft CAFO and a draft joint motion to withdraw the appeal on September 23, 2011, and that once the Region receives the signed signature pages from the Respondent, the Region will obtain the signatures from the appropriate officials in the Region.

For good cause shown, the Region's requests for an extension to file its response and for continuation of the stay are **GRANTED**. The Region's response to the appeal is to be filed no later than October 21, 2011.
