SECOND SCHEDULING ORDER ON ORAL ARGUMENT

Oral argument in this matter has been scheduled for **Thursday, September 2, 2021**, beginning at **1:30 p.m. Eastern Time**. Order Scheduling Oral Argument 1 (EAB June 15, 2021). We will hold the oral argument by videoconference rather than in the Administrative Courtroom in Washington, D.C.¹

We have allocated eighty (80) minutes for oral presentations by petitioners and respondents, divided as follows and in the following order: forty (40) minutes for petitioners, followed by forty (40) minutes for respondents (twenty-five (25) minutes for the Region and fifteen (15) minutes for General Electric Company). In addition, we will allocate five (5) minutes to each amicus which wishes to present oral argument. Petitioners may reserve up to ten

¹ As of the date of this Order, most EPA employees continue to work remotely, and there are conditions for entry into the EPA Headquarters Building in Washington, D.C. where the Administrative Courtroom is located. Petitioners for the Housatonic River Initiative and the Housatonic Environmental Action League have requested, with the assent of the Region and General Electric Company, that oral argument be held by videoconference. Assented-to Request for Oral Argument to be Held Virtually 1 (July 29, 2021).

(10) minutes of their forty-minute time allocation for rebuttal. No video or audio recording of the oral argument is permitted. A court reporter will transcribe the argument and we will post a transcript of the argument to the docket in this matter.

Petitioners, respondents, and amici wishing to present oral argument must file a “Notice of Participation” on or before **Tuesday, August 17, 2021** providing (1) the name(s) and contact information for the individual(s) who will present argument on its behalf, and (2) the name(s) and contact information for any other person(s) whose participation in the oral argument is deemed necessary. The Clerk of the Board will contact the parties in advance of the argument to provide further information regarding logistics and to schedule a videoconference approximately one week before the oral argument to identify and resolve any potential technical issues. We will make every effort to provide the public with view-only access to the oral argument.
