The Department of Health (DOH), Clean Water Branch (CWB) is unable to complete the processing of the subject renewal application prior to the permit expiration at midnight on September 8, 2009.

Therefore, in accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), Chapter 342D-6(h), the DOH hereby administratively extends the subject NPDES permit until a final determination on your application is made. The State DOT-HWYS shall not be held in violation of HRS, Chapter 342D, and Hawaii Administrative Rules, Chapter 11-54 and 11-55, during the pendency of its application, so long as it acts consistently with the permit presently granted.

It is the Permittee's responsibility to ensure that anyone working under this administrative extension of your permit understands and complies with the terms and conditions therein.
