ORDER EXTENDING STAY OF PROCEEDINGS

On December 15, 2014, Region 1 ("Region") of the U.S. Environmental Protection

Agency and General Electric Aviation ("GE") jointly filed a settlement negotiations status report

and a request to extend the current stay of proceedings for an additional sixty days. The

Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") previously granted a stay of proceedings through

January 2, 2015, so that the parties could attempt to settle some or all of the issues presented in
the petition for review that GE filed on October 30, 2014. The petition for review challenges
several conditions of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit that the Region
issued to GE on September 30, 2014.

The parties aver that they, along with the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection ("MassDEP"), have made significant progress in their settlement negotiations. Specifically, the parties and MassDEP have conducted two lengthy negotiation sessions and exchanged a substantial amount of written materials to both share information and propose ideas for settlement. Although the parties have reached an agreement in principle to resolve some of the straightforward issues presented in the petition for review, they request more time to develop and share information and further evaluate whether and how some of the more complex issues

may be resolved. The parties are optimistic that a full settlement can be reached if they have additional time to focus on their negotiations.

Upon consideration, the Board grants the parties' joint motion to stay the proceedings in the above-captioned appeal until March 3, 2015. Due to the federal holiday that falls on the parties' requested date to file a status report, the Region, in consultation with GE, shall file a status report no later than February 13, 2015, to update the Board on the progress of the parties' efforts to resolve the challenges to the permit contained in the petition for review. The parties shall inform the Board as soon as practicable of any settlement agreement they reach. The Board will decide whether to establish a briefing schedule or take other action based on the contents of the status report.
