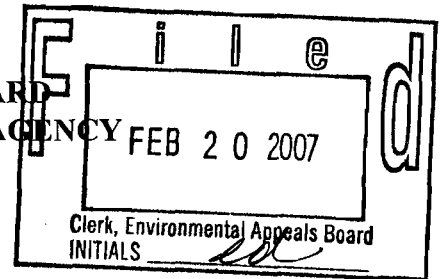

**ORDER GRANTING MOTION  
FOR SECOND STAY OF PROCEEDINGS**

On February 17, 2007, Region I of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency filed a status report and motion to stay the proceedings in the above-captioned matter. In its motion, the Region reports that it and the Town of Marion, the petitioner and permittee in this case, have successfully concluded a settlement of the disputed permit issues. The settlement will be implemented via a modification of the permit, which the Region intends to publish in draft form in early March, subject to a thirty-day notice and comment period. The Region and the Town of Marion request that the proceedings in this appeal continue to be stayed until June 1, 2007, in order to allow sufficient time for the permit modification process to conclude.

For good cause shown, the motion is hereby **GRANTED**. Region I's February 19, 2007 filing deadline is rescinded, and the Region is directed to file a response to the petition for review in this case on or before **June 1, 2007**.


